As Often As You...The Practice of the Supper
1 Corinthians 11:17-34

The Destructive Power of Division (1 Corinthians 11:17-22).

“When you come together, it is not the Lord's supper that you eat. For in eating, each one goes ahead with his own meal. One goes hungry...”
